- UEP1 & 2: UEP1 is a 4-hour/week class in the winter term; UEP2 is a 2-hour/week class in the summer term.
- **ExMo1:** Pick 2 seminars of your choice from the ExMo1 + 2 course pool. In one of these, do a graded PL, in the other one an ungraded SL.
- ExMo2: Same as ExMo1.
- **SustMo:** You may choose to attend language classes, classes in different subject areas and/or complete an internship/semester abroad in an English-speaking country.
- **ReMo:** Attend a research seminar in your field of specialisation (literature, linguistics or cultural history) to prepare for your MA thesis.
- **SpecMo:** Pick 2 seminars of your choice from the SpecMo course pool. In one of these, do a graded PL, in the other one an ungraded SL.
- AWE1 & 2: Collect 9 CP for each module. Keep in mind 30 hours of work count for 1 CP so 9 CP is approximately equivalent to 270 hours. Activities that count towards your CPs include but are not limited to workshops, helping organize and/or participating in conferences, internships, small publications, tutoring.
